School Uniform Policy	
TOPS	 Lower Academy (Pre-Kindergarten – 5th Grade) Burgundy, white or jade (not hunter green) polo shirts with the school logo. Upper Academy (6th – 8th grade) Navy blue or gray polo shirts with the school logo. Shirts must fit neatly and not be oversized or undersized (no visible midriffs). Undershirts may be worn under the uniform and must be solid white or black and tucked in. Lower and Upper Academy Class or club spirit t-shirts are allowed on Wednesdays only.
BOTTOMS	 Lower Academy (Pre-Kindergarten – 5th Grade) Khaki pants, shorts, skirts or skorts. Length must be appropriate. Students must wear a belt. Upper Academy (6th – 8th grade) Khaki pants. Pants must be worn appropriately at the waist and not be oversized or undersized. Students must wear a belt. Lower and Upper Academy Jeans are not allowed unless it is a school approved activity. Jeans must be school appropriate (no jeggings, tights, or rips)
OUTERWEAR	Sweatshirts, sweaters, and jackets must be in a solid color in the uniform colors.
FOOTWEAR	Only closed shoes or sneakers will be permitted.
UNACCEPTABLE APPAREL	 Attire must be in accordance with the M-DCPS dress code (School Board Policy 5511 – Dress and Grooming). Unacceptable apparel includes, but is not limited to, the following: No graphic design or statement pieces No leggings, Jeggings, skinny pants, jeans, pajama pants, etc. No house slippers, clogs, flip flops, sandals, etc. No hats or any other items that the school determines to be a distraction.
PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITIES	Monitoring of compliance with uniform policy will be ongoing. If a student is not in compliance their parent/guardian will be contacted to provide the correct uniform item.

^{*}On a school identified no uniform day – student must wear attire appropriate for school (no midriffs, jeggings, tights or ripped clothing) length must be appropriate.
