- Select and read **one** chapter book from the reading series titled **Field Trip Mysteries** by Steve Brezenoff.

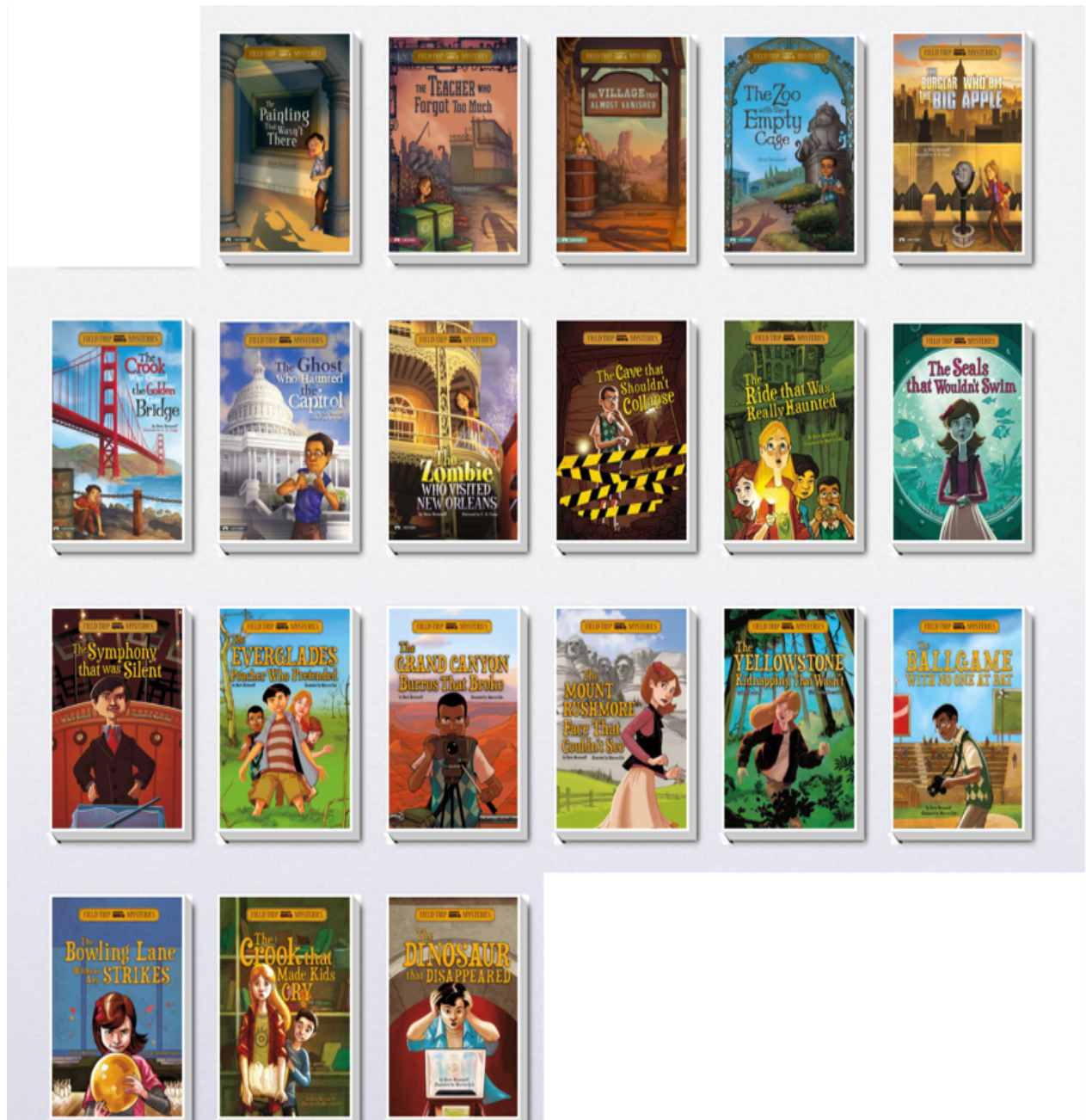

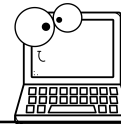
- journal entries **must be completed by the student**, written neatly, answered in complete sentences, and should include evidence from the text.









**Step 1** – Go to [dadeschools.net](https://dadeschools.net) and access the student portal. Then click on the “Schoolology” icon.




**Step 2** – Sign into Microsoft using your child's school email.


**Step 3** – Enter your child's password.




**Step 4** – In Schoolology, click on the “waffle” at the top.
