

For the safety of all students and staff, in the event of severe rain, thunder and/or lightning storms, please note that students WILL NOT BE dismissed through the regular driveway areas until the weather subsides. Parents will need to park and pick up students directly from the identified designated areas below. All students should carry a poncho/raincoat in their backpacks daily.

SEVERE WEATHER DISMISSAL PLAN

AFTER SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM: Students will report to their regularly assigned area once the weather permits.

BUS: Students will be escorted (Pk-1) to the Media Center and once the weather subsides to designated bus pick-up area. Students in 2^{nd} - 8^{th} Grade will report to the Media Center. Once the buses arrive and the weather subsides students will be escorted to their bus area.

WALKERS: Students will follow the procedures set forth by their rainy weather dismissal plan.

PARENT PICK-UP: Students will remain in the designated dismissal area. Parents/guardians will need to park and walk to pick up students from their dismissal locations. Please review locations listed below:

<u>Pre-K and Kindergarten (Room 902):</u> Parents will pick up from the middle school entrance.

Wednesdays Only: pick up will be via Middle School Driveway entrance to individual kindergarten classrooms.

<u>First Grade (Media Center)</u>: Parents will walk through the main entrance to the front of the media center to pick up their child(ren).

<u>Second Grade (Music Room)</u>: Parents will walk through the main entrance to the front of the music room to pick up their child(ren)

Third Grade (Art Room): Parents will walk through the main entrance to the front of the art room to pick up their child(ren)

<u>Fourth Grade (Room 86)</u> Parents will walk through the PE Pavilion to the double doors to pick up their child(ren)

Fifth Grade (Room 85): Parents will walk through the PE pavilion to the double doors to pick up their child(ren)

<u>Upper Academy - Middle School (6th Grade: Rm 902, 7th Grade: Rm. 907, 8th Grade Rm: 904):</u> Parents will pick up students from the middle school entrance if students cannot be contained in the entrance overhang.
