



Summer Reading Project for Incoming Fifth Graders

Dear Parents/Guardians of Incoming Fifth Graders,

This summer, your child will be expected to read at least one of the 2024-2025 Sunshine State books from the attached list. After reading their one book of choice, students must complete a summer reading book project for a grade. The book report project that the Fifth-Grade students should complete is a Power Point Presentation.

Power Point Slide Instructions

Each Slide should have the following:

Slide 1

- •Title- title of the book, author, and genre on the title slide, and the student's name on the bottom right-hand corner.
- •Setting- should have an illustration of the main setting of the book and a written description of the setting.
- •Main Character-should have an <u>illustration of the main character</u> and a written description of who the character is and explain why the character is important to the story.
- •Secondary Characters- should have an <u>illustration of other important characters</u> in the story and a written description of important character traits demonstrated throughout the story.

•Slide 2

- •Summary- Complete summary of the key events in the story. This should include the rising action (conflict), climax or turning point, falling action (resolution) of the story.
- •Theme-should have the theme, lesson, or message of the story and should explain what you learned from the story.
- •Rating-give your book a star rating from 1 to 5. Write an explanation on why you would or would not recommend this book to your classmates.

This project will be due on Friday, September 6th. We urge your child to be ORIGINAL and CREATIVE since this will be their first required assignment for their 5th grade reading class. In addition, during the first two weeks of school, your child will take an Accelerated Reader quiz on the book that they selected. The Power Point presentation and the Accelerated Reader quiz score will be their first Reading and Language Arts grades for the school year. Thank you,

- Main Character-should have an <u>illustration of the</u> main character and a written description of who the character is and explain why the character is important to the story.
- Secondary Characters- should have an <u>illustration</u> of other important characters in the story and a written description of important character traits demonstrated throughout the story.

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Summary

Complete summary of the key events in the story.
This should include the rising action (conflict),
climax or turning point, falling action (resolution) of
the story.

Theme/ Book Rating

 Theme-should have the <u>theme</u>, <u>lesson</u>, <u>or</u> message of the story and should explain what you learned from the story.

Rating-give your book a star rating from 1 to 5. Write an explanation on why you would or would not recommend this book to your classmates.
